



## Retirement Privileges Afforded to Faculty Retirees by UBC & and/or the UBC Emeritus College\*

<b>Privileges</b>	<b>Comments</b>

Emeritus Status	Granted by UBC Senate to those who are eligible for emeritus status. See <i>UBC Senate Policy V-250.2 Emeritus Status</i>
Complimentary parking permit	For UBC Senate-designated Emeriti. Also, for full-time faculty with 25 years of service who are retired & no longer on the UBC payroll. Visit: <i>UBC Quarter Century Club</i>
UBCcard for Emeriti and other retired faculty	Serves as your library card. Provides free access to MOA, Nitobe & Botanical Gardens, Beaty Biodiversity Museum. Price reductions at UBC Bookstore, other campus venues.
Library card (aka UBCcard)	Free for faculty retirees.
Internet access and E-mail continuance	Free for faculty retirees.
UBC Aquatic Centre	Rate reduction for retirees age 65 with 25 years of full-time UBC service. Visit: <i>UBC Quarter Century Club</i> . Faculty retiree who is 65 without 25 years of full-time service pays a slightly higher rate.
UBC Faculty Pension Plan	Option to leave pension funds within the UBCFPP and/or move funds to external financial institution(s). May transfer in registered funds from a Canadian financial institution or a previous employer.
Optional enrollment in <i>UBC Retirement and Survivor Benefits Program (Insurance)</i>	Administered by Sun Life. Includes Extended Health Care (EHC) (with limited emergency travel insurance), Dental insurance, Employee & Family Assistance Program (EFAP).
Optional enrollment in the health insurance plans secured by UBC Emeritus College, e.g., emergency travel, extended health care (EHC) and dental insurance	Must be <i>eligible</i> for membership in the College. Insurance options include MEDOC (Emerg. Travel); Johnson Inc.: Combined EHC/Emergency Travel or Stand-alone EHC, Dental Care Plans; RTO: Combined EHC/Emergency Travel, Dental & Hospitalization.
UBC Emeritus College	Enjoy the many benefits, programs and activities. Represents all retired UBC faculty, librarians, academic administrators.
UBC Tuition Waivers	1. For dependent children of Emeriti. 2. BC residents, age 65 and over, are eligible for free tuition at all BC universities. 3. Emeriti under age 65 are eligible for 12 credits per year of free tuition at UBC.
Office space and other academic support	Not automatic—must be negotiated with your Department.
